

Seminary Projects

The completion of the Reformed Confessions series by our Academic Dean, James T. Dennison, Jr., marks the end of an eight-year project. 127 confessions from 1523 to 1693 have been published in four volumes totaling 3105 pages followed by a 159-page index of names, subjects and Scripture proof-texts for the whole set. Confessions from Switzerland to Scotland, from the Netherlands to New England, from Hungary to Brazil are included as a testimony to the spread of the Reformed faith in the Christian world during the formative 16th and 17th centuries. Each confession is preceded by an historical introduction with information on the background which gave rise to the statement of faith.
